RACE COURSE (USAT&F Certification No. CT07021JHP): Start on Grand Street; East on Grand to South Main Street; Right onto South Main Street; Right onto West Liberty Street; Left onto Bank Street; Right onto Riverside Street; Right onto West Main Street; Across Meadow Street to continue on West Main Street; Right onto Bank Street; Right onto Grand Street; Grand Street to the Finish Line at intersection with State Street.

**Directions and Parking Information:**

**From Danbury Area and Points West (New York State) (I-84 East):** Take I-84 east to Exit 21/Meadow Street. At bottom of ramp, stay in the right lane. At next light, turn right onto Field Street. Entrance to the **Municipal Parking Garage** (across from the State Armory) is on the right. To walk to Library Park: Turn right out of the garage, go to end of Field Street and turn left onto Grand Street. Park is down the street on the left.

**From Hartford Area (and New England States) (I-84 West):** Take I-91 or I-84 to Hartford. From Hartford, follow I-84 west to Exit 21/Meadow Street. At bottom of ramp, bear right onto Field Street (Crossroads Cantina will be on your left). The entrance to the **Municipal Parking Garage** (directly across from the State Armory) is on the right. To walk to Library Park: Turn right out of the garage, go to end of Field Street and turn left onto Grand Street. Park is down the street on the left.

**From Points North of Waterbury and Litchfield County (Route 8 South):** Take Route 8 south to Exit 32/Riverside Street. At the light, turn left; stay straight through the next light and cross the bridge. You are now on Freight Street. At the next light, stay in the middle lane; take a right onto Meadow Street. At the next light, continue straight, stay in the left lane. At the next light, turn left at the stop sign (Crossroads Cantina will be on your left), continue straight on Field Street. Entrance to the **Municipal Parking Garage** (directly across from the State Armory) is on the right. To walk to Library Park: Turn right out of the garage, go to end of Field Street and turn left onto Grand Street. Park is down the street on the left.

**From Bridgeport Area and Fairfield County (Route 8 North)** Take I-95 to Route 8 northbound. When you reach Waterbury, take the exit for I-84 East toward Hartford. Stay in the right lane, which will be the ramp for Exit 21/Meadow Street. At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn right; you are now on Meadow Street. At the next light, turn right onto Field Street. At the stop sign (Crossroads Cantina will be on the left), continue straight on Field Street. Entrance to the **Municipal Parking Garage** (directly across from the State Armory) is on the right. To walk to Library Park: Turn right out of the garage, go to end of Field Street and turn left onto Grand Street. Park is down the street on the left.
