Where: Registration, start, & finish located at the Morris Town Beach pavilion on Bantam Lake. Located off of East Shore Rd. in Morris, CT.

Facilities: An USATF Sanctioned event. Restrooms! We have mile marks, digital timing, and computer results by Greystone Electronics. The course starts at the pavilion, takes a left onto E.Shore Rd. There's a steady climb to about 1.4 miles where the course takes a left onto the scenic Marsh Point Rd (gravel). Proceed down Marsh Point Rd and bear right at the fork. Proceed counter-clockwise around the triangle/cul de sac and back up Marsh Point Rd, take a right onto E. Shore and proceed directly back to the start line. An out-and-back with a little loop.
